
Everyone can support the work of Interplast, whether you're part of a workplace, school, community group or an individual.

FUNDRAISING IS AS SIMPLE AS...

- 1. Reading this kit to understand your responsibilities as a fundraiser for Interplast, and deciding on the fundraising event you'd like to hold.
- 2. Filling out a registration form (attached) and emailing it to us on contactus@interplast.org.au so we can send you an authority to fundraise letter.
- 3. Creating your own fundraising page using our customised Go Fundraise page, which you can share with family, friends and colleagues.







YOUR FUNDRAISER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Fundraising can only commence once you have received a letter of authority.
- It must be clear in all communication that you do not represent Interplast, but all funds you raise will be donated to our work.
- Activities are taken at your risk and any necessary permits, insurance or licenses must be obtained by you.
- Copies of all publicity should be forwarded to us for approval before publication.
- You are not covered by Interplast's public liability insurance.

- Interplast does not give permission for door to door requests or soliciting donations in public.
- All funds should be forwarded to us within two weeks. Tax deductible receipt can be issued upon request.
- You are responsible for all costs and debts associated with the fundraising activity.
 You may deduct reasonable event costs.
- Interplast reserves the right to withdraw approval for the activity if you fail to meet the above responsibilities.

HOW WE CAN SUPPORT YOU

We can provide:

- Supply of resources such as the Interplast brochure, bookmarks, copies of annual reports, newsletters and donation boxes
- Supply of Interplast's supporters logo
- Electronic access to photos, short films and posters through our website
- Interplast volunteer speakers to present at your event (dependent on availability)
- Publicity of your event through our social media channels
- Tax deductible receipts for donors
- Staff members to attend your event and accept donations (dependent on availability)
- A certificate of appreciation post event to acknowledge your support

We can't provide:

- Interplast staff to help coordinate or market your event
- Reimbursement for any expenses incurred from your event (you may deduct any reasonable costs)
- Prizes, auction and raffle items
- Contact lists for you to use in promoting your event (due to privacy legislation)



CASE STUDY

Young brothers with dreams – the Philippines (Cagayan de Oro)

In the Philippines, the Interplast team met Jeffrey aged 3, Jekli aged 5 and Rene aged 7, three brothers with cleft lips and palates. The social stigma associated with these conditions meant that all three had experienced bullying throughout their young lives.

The boys' parents worked as farm labourers earning only around \$2.50 per day, and they could not afford to pay for surgery for the boys.

On behalf of the family, a local parish priest contacted a Rotarian who knew of the upcoming visit of an Interplast team to Cagayan de Oro. The boys made the five-

hour journey from Bukidnon with their parents to meet the surgical team, hopeful that this would be their chance at a new life. When the family arrived, the surgical team assessed the boys, and all three brothers were identified as priorities for surgery during the program activity.

In a matter of hours, the lives of the boys were changed forever. All three surgeries were successful, and the brothers are now free from the stigma associated with their conditions. Jeffrey, Jekli and Rene all want to be teachers when they grow up, a dream that is now within their reach thanks to the Interplast team, and local medical and Rotarian partners in the Philippines.
